A Suggested Theme:

Christ the Eternal King

- Matthew 2:2** “Where is He Who has been born **King** of the Jews?” - The Wise Men to Herod
- Matthew 21:5** “Say to the daughter of Zion, ‘Behold your **King** is coming to you, gentle, and mounted on a donkey.’”
- Matthew 27:29** “And after weaving a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand; and they kneeled down before Him and mocked Him, saying, ‘Hail, **King** of the Jews.’” - The soldiers mock Him
- Matthew 27:37** “And they put up above His head the charges against Him which read, ‘This is Jesus the **King** of the Jews.’”
- John 18:37** “Pilate therefore said to Him, ‘So You are a **king**?’ Jesus answered, ‘You say correctly that I am a **King**. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My Voice.’”
- Revelation 19:11-16** “And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, ‘**King of Kings**, and Lord of Lords.’”
