The pay is \$20 each time.

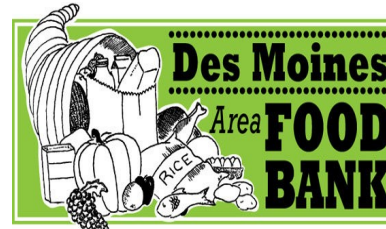
