
Teen Happenings

Jesus Christ the Obedient Servant

“The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because He has anointed me... He has sent me ...” **Luke 4:18-19**

“My food,” said Jesus, ‘is to do the will of Him who sent me and to finish His work.’” **John 4:34**

“The One who sent me is with me; He has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases Him.” **John 8:29**
