What's Happening for DMGC Kids and Teens?

Teens — Meet Tuesdays and Thursdays at 4:00 PM on ZOOM for a Bible lesson, discussion and games. We're having board game /hang out nights over Zoom every couple of weeks. This week we had a prayer meeting during our Tuesday session for our community, nation and world, as well as an open discussion to find out how students were processing everything happening right now. We had a follow-up conversation on Thursday about Biblical Justice and encouraged students to think through how they can be a light in our world right now.

Kids — On Fridays, parents have been receiving two or three options for Sunday School for Sunday morning. Awana is meeting weekly on Zoom — Wednesdays from 3:30-4:30 PM. We split the group and teach a short lesson based on the Awana curriculum, play a game, check in with the kids to see how they're doing and pray for them. The kids are enjoying "seeing" each other! The last couple of weeks we've been playing a Coronacation Elimination game, which has been a hit! We also finished the Awana curriculum this week, so we will be switching to something different next week.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we are reimagining camp for the 2020 camping season. It is our hope that this plan will bring some much-needed recreation at camp, and most importantly allow us to keep spreading the love of Jesus Christ through the LBC ministry.



What will be offered?

Youth Programming will be offered for six weeks. There will be one week of digital camp for each age group that will include daily virtual programming.
